Haverhill Cricket Club Code of Conduct for Officials and Volunteers



The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below.

All must abide by the following:

- Consider the wellbeing and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability, and experience of those taking part.
- Never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- Promote the positive aspects of cricket.
- Never condone rule violations, rough play, or the use of prohibitive substances.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by ECB Coaches Association and Haverhill Cricket Club Coaches.
- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover.
- Haverhill Cricket Club believes that cricket coaches must respect and champion the rights of every individual to participate in cricket.
